I will play safe in the free play area. My counselor can help me remember where the free play area begins and ends.

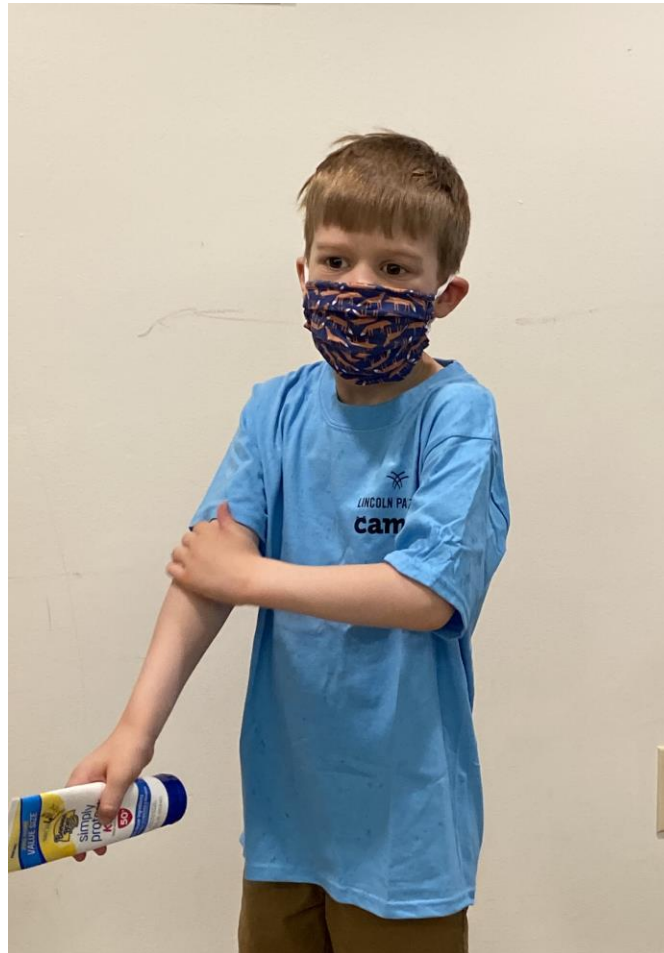
**I will stay with my group inside buildings.
