- ☐ Flashlights, fairy lights, or glow in the dark items

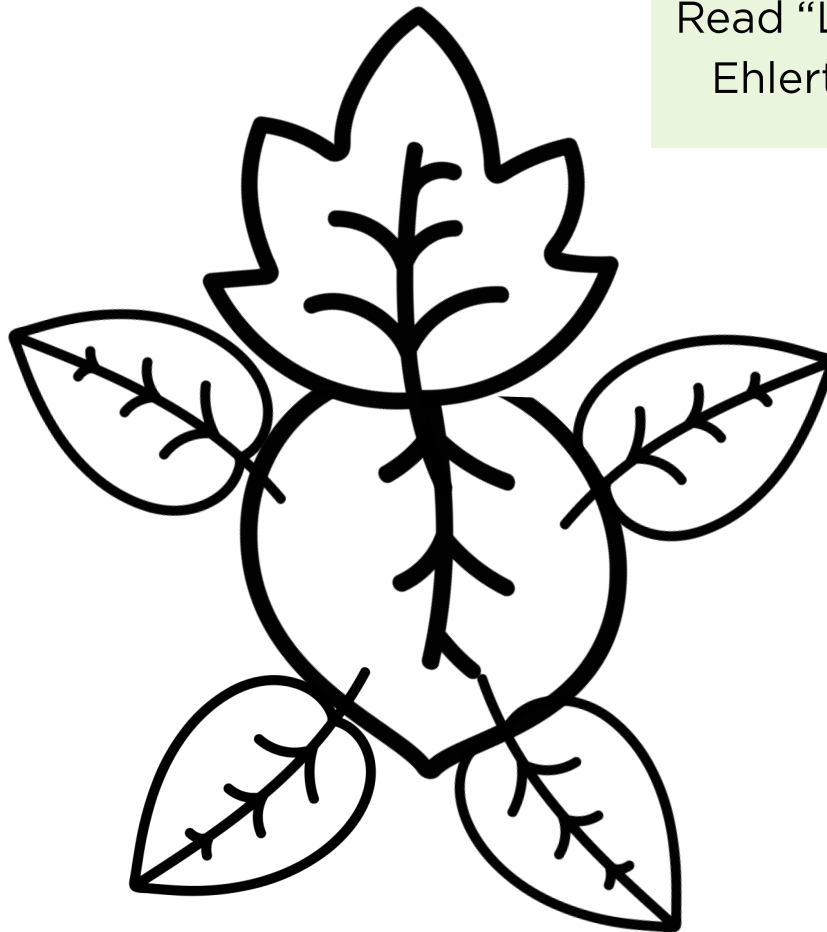
Don't forget to take your fort building outdoors! Sturdy sticks and nature treasures are excellent additions to any fort. Happy building!

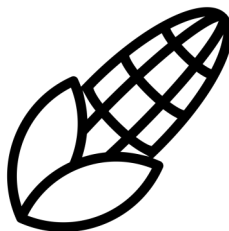
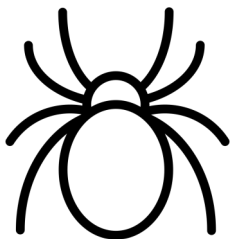
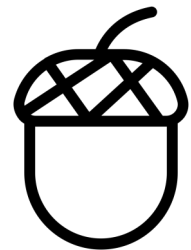
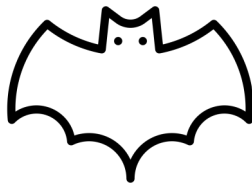
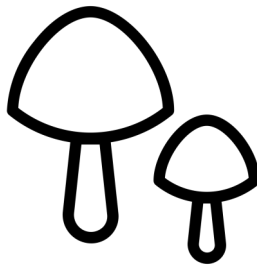
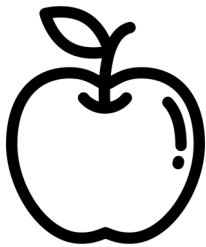
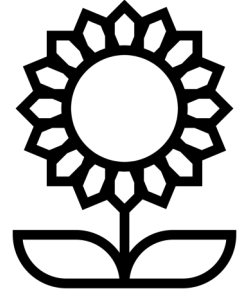
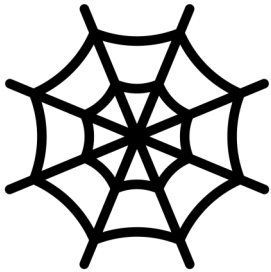
Nature Art
